Agribusiness in Argentina

- Argentina is the world's 5th largest food exporter
 - Agribusiness accounts for 18.5% of GDP
 - o 36% of all direct and indirect employment
 - o 45% of added value in manufacturing
 - o 56% of all exports
 - US\$ 20 billion in annual foreign earnings
- Grain harvest to reach 100 million tonnes by 2010
- Imported agricultural machinery sales up by 75% (2007)
- World' main exporter of soybean, 98% is GMO

Population of 38.5 m of which 89% live in urban areas

Main cities: Buenos Aires 11.5 m, Cordoba 1.3 m, Rosario 1.1 m, and Mendoza 0.7m

Argentina covers 2.8 M km2 (approx 11x larger than UK)

Economy

Highest GDP growth in Latin America in recent years (five years of growth at over 8%)

Per capita GDP highest in Latin America US\$ 15,000 (PPP method)

Stable exchange rate: US\$ 1=3.15 Argentine Pesos
